Developing Spiritual Sensitivity 030324ekk

INTRO.

I have been sharing with you the importance of becoming spiritual ... To break this point down a bit more – I am actually talking about becoming "spiritually sensitive" ... Once we become spiritually sensitive – Both in soul and spirit – we will be able to navigate this life very easily ... The reason many struggle so much with the things of this world – is because they are not spiritually sensitive so that they may discern the signs of the times – and make an appropriate plan to navigate the issues of life ... Everything in this natural realm has a spiritual dynamic attached with it ... This is simply common sense and it boggles my mind that people struggle with this concept ... A Spirit – Elohim created everything ... HE created man in His image which is spirit ... The Words HE speaks is Spirit ... So, understanding these elementary concepts – how can anyone believe that anything is this realm doesn't have a spiritual component to it? ... Just look at the evil all around us – that ought to be enough proof right there – that there is a spiritual component to everything in this realm.

So – why is this point so important to grasp? ... You will never become spiritually sensitive – if you do not believe there are spiritual dynamics or spirit beings functioning in this natural realm ... We are to be the greatest of all the spiritual beings that are functioning upon this earth

So, let's lay some foundational concepts as we seek to understand and enhance our spiritual sensitivity

Foundational Concepts

Our Flesh / Soul is spiritual in nature – to the place where – we can discern "spiritual things"

Have you ever sensed the presence of God – say in our time of worship? ... There are times where His presence – is so tangible in this place – that it causes people to cry and sometimes laugh ... Have you ever felt a breeze blow by you? ... Or feel like something touched you or brush across your face? ... How about the door behind me – when it simply opened all by itself – when I was preaching ... How about you saw something out of the corner of your eye ... Have you ever felt chill-bumps? ... Have you ever felt your body vibrate or feel heavy like something was sitting on you? ... Let's get really practical – how many of you have ever walked into a room of people and went whoa – there are some bad vibes in here? ... These are all manifestations of the flesh sensing things of the spirit.

Now catch this – this is the lowest form of spiritual sensitivity you can function in ...

Unfortunately – some cannot even function at this level ... Know what is sad – I have had people tell me – in the past for full disclosure – that they do not sense the spirit of God – here in the church – as if there is something wrong with me or this body.

Matthew 18:20 Expanded Bible

This is true because if [For where] two or three people ·come [are assembled/gathered] together in My Name, - I Am there ·with them [among them; in their midst]."

So – according to this scripture – if you are here in this place and you do not sense the presence of God ... Then by your own admission – you are neither fleshly nor spiritually sensitive enough to know He is here ... The issue isn't that the Lord isn't present ... The issue is you are spiritually insensitive or spiritually dead ... I don't mean to be harsh – but let's be biblically

accurate – amen! ... This is why it is so important to understand this principle and develop ourselves in this area of becoming more spiritually sensitive.

So again, Because we are designed as spiritual beings, we have the ability to sense "spiritual things" through our soul/flesh ... We should also seek to develop these senses – but remember this is the lowest form of spiritual discernment ... Now let me caution you ... When sensing spiritual things from the flesh/soul – we can get into the area of presumption and assumption ... Be careful because:

"The heart is fooled more than anything else, - and is very sinful. ... Who can know how bad it is?

We Learn in our Flesh/Soul nature to be Spiritually Sensitive by Observing Patterns

Beware of the Dangers of Relying upon your Fleshly/Soulish Discernment

Never Rely solely upon your fleshly/soulish senses of discernment

So, the other disciples kept telling him, - - "We have seen the Lord!" ... But he said to them, - - "Unless I see - in His hands the marks of the nails, - and put my finger into the nail prints, - and put my hand into His side, ... I will never believe."

We live by what we believe will happen, ... not by what we can see.

Be Cautious and Recognize Sensory Overload

Col. 2:8 Passion

Beware that no one - distracts you - or intimidates you in their attempt - to lead you away from Christ's fullness - by pretending to be full of wisdom - when they're filled with endless arguments of human logic. ... For they operate with humanistic and clouded judgments - based on the mindset of this world system, - and not the anointed truths of the Anointed One.

The eye is the lamp of your body. ... When your eye is clear [spiritually perceptive, focused on God], - your whole body also is full of light [benefiting from God's precepts]. ... But when it is bad [spiritually blind], your body also is full of darkness [devoid of God's word]. ... 35 Be careful, therefore, that the light that is in you is not darkness.

TAKE AWAY

Those who are in the place of struggling with spiritual sensitivity ... You struggle in this area of fleshly/soulish discernment – nether mind spiritual discernment of your spirit man which is

completely different from soulish discernment ... Let me help you receive the blessings of the Lord while you are developing yourself in spiritual sensitivity
