INTRO.

Matthew 13:11-15 The Message

He replied, - - "You've been given insight into God's kingdom. ... You know how it works. ...

Not everybody has this gift, - this insight; - - it hasn't been given to them. ... Whenever someone has a ready heart for this, ... the insights and understandings flow freely. ... But if there is no readiness, - any trace of receptivity soon disappears. ... That's why I tell stories: to create readiness, - to nudge the people toward a welcome awakening. ... In their present state they can stare till doomsday and not see it, - listen till they're blue in the face and not get it. ... I don't want Isaiah's forecast repeated all over again:

Your ears are open but you don't hear a thing. ... Your eyes are awake but you don't see a thing. ... The people are stupid! ... They stick their fingers in their ears so they won't have to listen; ... They screw their eyes shut so they won't have to look, ... so they won't have to deal with me face-to-face and let me heal them.

What is a "Ready Heart?"
