INTRO.

What is going to make 2019 different from other years? ... How will these prophetic words of Birthing a Kingdom movement ... New Wine ... New Mantles of Grace ... Come to pass?

Key#1 Expectancy

What are you expecting for 2019? ... Are you making preparations for what you are expecting? ... Are you building bigger barns in expectation of a bigger harvest? ... Are you creating a New Wineskin so that you can receive fresh revelation from the Spirit? ... Are you cleansing the Temple in order to receive new mantles of Grace? ... The “Old” can not house the “New”

1 Chronicles 4:10 (NKJV)

And Jabez called on the God of Israel saying, “Oh, that **You would bless me indeed**, ... and **enlarge my territory**, ... that Your hand would be with me, ... and that You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain!” ... So, God granted him what he requested.

The Next Three Keys are found in:

Luke 8:35 (VOICE)

Soon a crowd rushes from the town to see what’s going on out by the lake. ... There they find **Jesus seated to teach** ... with the newly liberated man ... **sitting at His feet learning in the posture of a disciple**. ... This former madman is now **properly dressed** ... and **completely sane**. ... **This frightens the people**.

Key #2 Proper Positioning

Are you taking the posture of a disciple?

Are you Sitting? ... Are you Learning? ... Are you allowing a 5-fold minister to speak into your life so that you may be equipped? ... What about your attitude? ... Do you possess the attitude of a disciple? ... An attitude of submission - humility - teachability? ... Are you correctable?

Luke 10:38-39 (TPT)

As Jesus and the disciples continued on their journey, they came to a village where a woman welcomed Jesus into her home. Her name was Martha and she had a sister named Mary. ...

Mary sat down attentively before the Master, ... absorbing every revelation he shared.

Key #3 Properly Dressed ... “This former madman is now properly dressed”

Former madman

Galatians 1:13 (TPT)

By now you have heard stories ... *{you are familiar with my personal history,}* ... of how severely I harassed and persecuted Christians and did my best to systematically destroy God’s church, all because of my radical devotion to the Jewish religion.

1 Timothy 1:13 (AMP)

Even though I was formerly a blasphemer [of our Lord] ... and a persecutor [of His church] ... and a shameful and outrageous and violent aggressor [toward believers]. ... Yet I was shown mercy because I acted out of ignorance in unbelief.

Never forget your past as it was a formative part of your journey ... Never dwell in the past nor allow others to condemn you for your past

Romans 8:1 (NKJV)

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, ... who do not walk according to the flesh, ... but according to the Spirit.

Properly Dressed

Zechariah 3:1-4 (MSG)

Next the Messenger-Angel showed me the high priest Joshua. ... He was standing before God's Angel where the Accuser showed up to accuse him. ... Then God said to the Accuser, "I, God, rebuke you, Accuser! I rebuke you and choose Jerusalem. ... Surprise! ... Everything is going up in flames, but I reach in and pull out Jerusalem!" ... Joshua, standing before the angel, **was dressed in dirty clothes**. ... The angel spoke to his attendants, "Get him out of those filthy clothes," and then said to Joshua, "**Look, I've stripped you of your sin ... and dressed you up in clean clothes.**"

Isaiah 61:10 (NLT)

I am overwhelmed with joy in the Lord my God! ... For he has dressed me with the **clothing of salvation** ... and draped me in a **robe of righteousness**. ... I am like a bridegroom dressed for his wedding or a bride with her jewels.

Ephesians 6:10-11 (NKJV)

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. ... 11 Put on the **whole armor of God**, that you may be able to *stand against the wiles of the devil*.

Witchcraft - word curses which are designed to attack your right standing with God along with creating vain imaginations which lead to fear and doubt in your heart

Conclusion

Let me ask you,

Have you been clothed in salvation? ... Or are you still naked in trespasses and in sin? ... Have you confessed your sin and asked Jesus to be the Lord of your life?

Christian

When was the last time you washed your robe of righteousness?

Titus 3:5 (Msg)

It was all His doing; we had nothing to do with it. ... **He gave us a good bath**, ... and we came out of it - new people, ... **washed inside and out by the Holy Spirit**.

Ephesians 5:26-27 (TPT)

To make us holy and pure, ... **cleansing us through the showering of the pure water of the Word of God**. ... 27 All that He does in us is designed to make us a mature church for His pleasure, until we become a source of praise to him—glorious and radiant, beautiful and holy, without fault or flaw.

Remember - - Joshua the High Priest was standing before the angel in the Court of Heaven with dirty clothes

If we were standing in Joshua's place right now ... What would our clothes look like? ... I'm sure it wouldn't hurt any of us to take a good old fashion bath or a Holy Spirit shower - Amen

The altar is open ... Come and bathe in the water of His Spirit ... Allow the Holy Spirit to shower you with the pure water of heaven so that you may clean your robe of righteousness and walk out of here in beautiful, holy and without a spot of this sinful world attached to you
