Matthew 6:33 (AMP)

But first and most importantly seek (aim at, strive after) ... His Kingdom and His Righteousness [His way of doing and being right—the attitude and character of God], ... and all these things will be given to you also.

Without a Proper understanding and application of “Kingdom” - - You nor your situations will never change

Myles’s Quote - Kingdom defined

“A kingdom is the governing influence of a King over his territory,

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (AMP)

19 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is within you, whom you have [received as a gift] from God, and that you are not your own [property]? ... 20 You were bought with a price [you were actually purchased with the precious blood of Jesus and made His own]. So then, honor and glorify God with your body.

Philippians 2:13 (AMPC)

13 [Not in your own strength] for it is God Who is all the while effectually at work in you [energizing and creating in you the power and desire], both to will and to work for His good pleasure and satisfaction and delight.

Ephesians 2:10 (AMPC)

10 For we are God’s [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us

[taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live].

Romans 12:1-2 (NLT)

1 And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him. ... 2 Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

Luke 17:20-21 (AMPC)

20 Asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He replied to them by saying, - - The kingdom of God does not come with signs to be observed or with visible display, ... 21 Nor will people say, Look! Here [it is]! or, See, [it is] there! For behold, the kingdom of God is within you [in your hearts] and among you [surrounding you].

Faithfulness to the application Kingdom principles is imperative to your success

Luke 16:11-13 (AMPC)

11 Therefore if you have not been faithful in the [case of] unrighteous mammon (deceitful riches, money, possessions), who will entrust to you the true riches?

12 And if you have not proved faithful in that which belongs to another [whether God or man], who will give you that which is your own [that is, the true riches]?

13 No servant is able to serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will stand by and be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon (riches, or anything in which you trust and on which you rely).

Manifesting the Father's Kingdom in your life isn't about how many signs and wonders you can do ... Manifesting Kingdom is a result of "being" not "doing" ... Proof isn't through outward signs but from an inward character ... Pagans can do signs and wonders

Signs and Wonders are a gift from the Holy Spirit with the intent purpose of ministering to the other guy Manifestation of the Kingdom is a result of a change in "being" where you now have the ability to walk out and fulfill God's divine purpose and destiny for your life

Luke 5:36-39 (NLT)

36 Then Jesus gave them this illustration: “No one tears a piece of cloth from a new garment and uses it to patch an old garment. For then the new garment would be ruined, and the new patch wouldn’t even match the old garment.

You can’t put “new revelation” on top of “old revelation”

37 “And no one puts new wine into old wineskins. For the new wine would burst the wineskins, spilling the wine and ruining the skins. 38 New wine must be stored in new wineskins. 39 But no one who drinks the old wine seems to want the new wine. ‘The old is just fine,’ they say.”

You can’t receive a “new revelation” until you are no longer satisfied with the “old revelation”

Prosperity is the Father’s economic plan for His Kids

Why is Prosperity so hotly contested and debated in Christendom?

Lie#1

1. Well, we don’t want to give people false hope because it isn’t possible for everyone to become rich
2. Everyone isn’t supposed to become prosperous, didn’t God say you would always have the poor among you
3. We don’t want to give them a false impression of God

Numbers 23:19 (NKJV)

“God is not a man, that He should lie, ... Nor a son of man, that He should repent. ... Has He said, and will He not do? ... Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?”

Romans 3:4 (NKJV)

Certainly not! Indeed, let God be true but every man a liar. As it is written: “That You may be justified in Your words and may overcome when You are judged.”

John 8:31-32 (MSG)

Then Jesus turned to the Jews who had claimed to believe in him. “If you stick with this, living out what I tell you, you are my disciples for sure. Then you will experience for yourselves the truth, and the truth will free you.”

KINGDOM MINDSET

What you Believe - You will Receive

Proverbs 23:7 (AMP)

For as he thinks in his heart, so is he ... [in behavior—one who manipulates]. He says to you, “Eat and drink,” - Yet his heart is not with you [but it is begrudging the cost].

The guy’s “words” are correct - but his “heart” (belief) is wrong ... How many times do we “speak” the right words yet we never examine our heart to find out if we really believe what is coming out our mouth Often, people keep repeating “their words” (scripture) in an attempt to convince themselves that it is true “Fake it till you make it” is a lie from the devil.

Matthew 12:34 (GNT)

You snakes - - how can you say good things when you are evil? ... For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of.

Proverbs 18:21 (AMP)

Death and life are in the power of the tongue, ... And those who love it and indulge it will eat its fruit and ... bear the consequences of their words.

Romans 12:3 (AMP)

For by the grace [of God] given to me I say to every one of you - not to think more highly of himself [and of his importance and ability] than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as God has apportioned to each a degree of faith [and a purpose designed for service].

There are 5 talents; 3 talents and 1 talent people ... Be honest in your evaluation of yourself and understand the most important thing is to “function” within your God given design and assignment ... Stop trying to be something God never intended you to be and be the best person God designed you to be. ... BUT - never get comfortable! ... Continue to strive; extend; stretch yourself. Philippians 3:14 “I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus”

John 10:10 (NLT)

10 The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. ... My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life.

Deuteronomy 8:18 (NCV)

but remember the Lord your God! ... It is He who gives you the power to become rich, ... keeping the agreement he promised to your ancestors, as it is today.

Deuteronomy 28:1-14 (NLT)

1 "If you fully obey the Lord your God ... and ... carefully keep all his commands ... that I am giving you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the world. ... 2 You will experience all these blessings if you obey the Lord your God: ... 3 Your towns and your fields will be blessed. ... 4 Your children and your crops will be blessed. The offspring of your herds and flocks will be blessed. ... 5 Your fruit baskets and breadboards will be blessed. ... 6 Wherever you go and whatever you do, you will be blessed. ... 7 "The Lord will conquer your enemies when they attack you. They will attack you from one direction, but they will scatter from you in seven! ... 8 "The Lord will guarantee a blessing on everything you do and will fill your storehouses with grain. The Lord your God will bless you in the land he is giving you. ... 9 "If you obey the commands of the Lord your God and walk in his ways, the Lord will establish you as his holy people as he swore he would do. ... 10 Then all the nations of the world will see that you are a people claimed by the Lord, and they will stand in awe of you. ... 11 "The Lord will give you prosperity in the land he swore to your ancestors to give you, blessing you with many children, numerous livestock, and abundant crops. ... 12 The Lord will send rain at the proper time from his rich treasury in the heavens and will bless all the work you do. You will lend to many nations, but you will never need to borrow from them. ... 13 If you listen to these commands of the Lord your God that I am giving you today, and if you carefully obey them, the Lord will make you the head and not the tail, and you will always be on top and

never at the bottom. ... 14 You must not turn away from any of the commands I am giving you today, nor follow after other gods and worship them.

3 John 2 (AMP)

2 Beloved, I pray that in every way you may succeed and prosper and be in good health [physically], just as [I know] your soul prospers [spiritually].

Proverbs 10:22 (NLT)

The blessing of the Lord makes a person rich, and he adds no sorrow with it.

Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)

For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Lie #2 "I only need enough to meet my needs - I don't want to appear selfish"

2 Kings 4:1-7 (NLT)

1 One day the widow of a member of the group of prophets came to Elisha and cried out, "My husband who served you is dead, and you know how he feared the Lord. But now a creditor has come, threatening to take my two sons as slaves." ... 2 "What can I do to help you?" Elisha asked. "Tell me, what do you have in the house?" {Do you have anything of worth in your house?} "Nothing at all, except a flask of olive oil," she replied. ... 3 And Elisha said, "Borrow as many empty jars as you can from your friends and neighbors. ... 4 Then go into your house with your sons and shut the door behind you. Pour olive oil from your flask into the jars, setting each one aside when it is filled." ... 5 So she did as she was told. Her sons kept bringing jars to her, and she filled one after another. ... 6 Soon every container was full to the brim! "Bring me another jar," she said to one of her sons. "There aren't any more!" he told her. And then the olive oil stopped flowing. ... 7 When she told the man of God what had happened, he said to her, "Now sell the olive oil and pay your debts, and you and your sons can live on what is left over."

The Purpose of Prosperity ... Why do we need to be Prosperous?

To Take Care of God's House - Ekklesia

Malachi 3:10 (NKJV)

Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this," Says the Lord of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing, that there will not be room enough to receive it.

Acts 4:32-35 (NKJV)

32 Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common. ... 33 And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all. ... 34 Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, ... 35 and laid them at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.

To Take Care of Your House

1 Timothy 5:8 (NKJV)

But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

To Take Care of Your Children and Grandchildren's House

Proverbs 19:14 (NLT)

Fathers can give their sons an inheritance of houses and wealth, but only the Lord can give an understanding wife.

Proverbs 13:22 (NKJV)

A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, But the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous.

To Take Care of the House of Others

1 John 3:16-17 (NLT)

16 We know what real love is because Jesus gave up his life for us. So, we also ought to give up our lives for our brothers and sisters. ... 17 If someone has enough money to live well and sees a brother or sister in need but shows no compassion—how can God's love be in that person?

Proverbs 11:24-25 (NLT)

24 Give freely and become more wealthy; be stingy and lose everything. ... 25 The generous will prosper; those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed.

Proverbs 19:17 (NLT)

If you help the poor, you are lending to the Lord - and he will repay you!

Luke 6:38 (NKJV)

38 Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.”

Proverbs 4:7 (NKJV)

7 Wisdom is the principal thing; Therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding.
